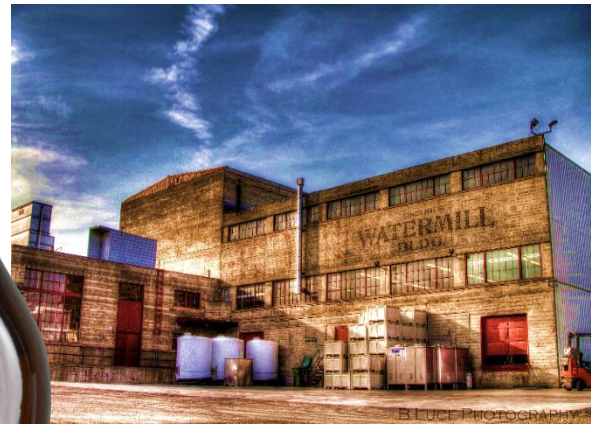

# BLUE MOUNTAIN PEAR CIDER

Our pear cider is a combination of our 5 apple base blend with juice made from pears grown in Washington State. While not a true Perry, the unmistakable notes of pear dominate both the flavor and the nose. A deep golden color denotes the weight of this medium to heavy bodied cider that coats the pallet and leaves a pleasant lingering flavor as if you have just bitten into a ripe pear..

- Apples:** Gravenstein, Pippin, Winesap, Jonagold, Golden Russet
- Pears:** Bartlett, Anjou, Bosc
- Orchards:** Blue Mountain Cider, Mt. Fuji and the Rocks, Treetop
- Appellation:** Walla Walla Valley, Columbia Valley
- Elevation:** 825ft-2,225ft
- Soil Type:** Freewater Cobblestone and Marine Sedimentary, Glacial silt deposit
